Who can enroll?

- Any teen who is pregnant or has a child and lives within the Salinas Union High School District attendance area
- A teen, 16 years and older, who is working toward a high school diploma

How does the program work?

- Each student registers for two classes:
 - One class in the infant care center working with babies and toddlers
 - One class of pre-natal or parenting education
 - The rest of the school day is a regular schedule of academic classes
